PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Mayor Jeff Rae from the Village of Berkey spoke in regards to the Class A sludge currently be applied by an area framer. Mayor Rae stated he met with 2 representatives from the Ohio EPA who were investigating the numerous complaints of the foul odors, they were in agreement the odor was strong.

The Ohio EPA determined that the sludge resulted in a nuisance odor and the permittee shall be required to minimize the creation of these odors. Unfortunately, at the current time incorporation of the bio-solids into the soil is not a feasible option as there are actively growing soybean and hay crops present on the sites.

The EPA has ruled in the future in order to minimize the nuisance odors, the bio-solids can only be applied when a crop in not actively growing and can be incorporated into the soil within 24 hours of application. The EPA will continue to monitor the foul orders.
