# **READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

## PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS:

# **PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Question on voice mail not working at the maintenance building; this has been repaired and is now working.

Discussion on the number of accidents on Central Avenue, with possibility of putting in a turn lane into Ozzies. Central Avenue is a state road; ODOT would have to make that decision

Reported that rail road ties were left on the corner of Kilburn Rd. and Sylvania Avenue.

#### FIRE:

Brush truck and Rescue truck are for sale on govdeals.com.

There has been an increase in accidents on Central Avenue.

Mutual Aid is provided to Metamora Fire Department everyday 24 hours a day due to their lack of volunteers. Richfield Township receives mutual aid every day from Sylvania Township.

Discussion on the "Cares Act Fund" money from COVID-19. Township received \$71,544.98 an additional amount will be sent in the next year. There are specific guide lines to follow for use of the funds. Chief Clonch would like to see the funds used toward a new ambulance, our current ambulance is old with mechanical issues.

## **ZONING:**

Zoning Inspector Smith provided a list along with photos of zoning violations in the township. Decision was made to address a couple at a time; Mr. Smith will send out zoning violation letters with photo's attached.

# **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Trustee Bick was asked by a resident if he could set up at the township building to give away free vegetables. The Trustees suggested he set up at the daycare center if they allow to reach more families.

Trustee Bick provided information on a TMACOG grant for water and sewage purposes.

## **ROADS:**

Lucas County Engineers office notified the township of the ODOT Township Stimulus Program. There is a funding limit of \$250,000.00 per project, ODOT will provide 100% of eligible costs for all phases of the project, up to the specified project funding limit. The project funds will be pre-paid to the township and must be spent by December 31, 2024. The Trustees agreed to submit the Miller Rd project for this funding.
